Dear Proposers:

This morning the Board of County Commissioners met on the record to establish a final proposer ranking for the above-described project. After comment and deliberation, including from members of the Review Committee, the Board voted to find and conclude that:

1. Each proposer is objectively competent and qualified to provide the requested services, and that the County would gladly work with all or any of them in the future as project and circumstance might allow; and
2. That the Review Committee's second round average scores for each proposer in the evaluation areas of Experience, Staff, and Approach be adopted for those reasons established by the record; and
3. That the Board issue its notice of ranking pursuant to Idaho Code section 67-2320 for this project as follows:

DLR - First  
CGL - Second  
LCA – Third


