This Addendum shall be considered part of Canyon County, Idaho's original Request for Proposals (RFP) for Ongoing Wood Waste Removal from Pickles Butte Sanitary Landfill and modifies the original RFP issued by the Board of County Commissioners on June 24, 2019.

The following questions were timely submitted with regard to the County's RFP, referenced above. Following each question is the County's response/clarification.

Questions/Answers:

Q1.a. What is the distance of the water source from the wood pile?

A1.a. The current water source is a canal approximately 3 miles from the clean wood pile. Current vendor pumps water into a vendor-owned truck at that source and transports it to the clean wood pile.

Q1.b. Is there a cost for the water to the vendor?

A1.b. The water currently sourced from a landfill-owned water right and there is no cost to the vendor for water itself.

Q2. Timber Creek feels there is a time constraint for the annual report and audited financial statements before the due date of the RFP. Will company prepared financial statements suffice?

A2. The most recent annual report is required where one exists. If no such report exists, then the most recent audited financial statements are required.

Q3. How many printed copies of the RFP are required for submission?

A3. One (1) hard copy, and one (1) digital copy (to be provided on disc or USB flash drive to be retained by the County). Digital documents should be in PDF format.
