Miscellaneous Clarifications:

1. The following information as well as the Solicitation of Bids in PDF format will be available on the County website at www.canyonco.org.
2. Bids must be identified with the subject line "FY2020 Pickles Butte Sanitary Landfill Well Abandonment Project" and be received by Thursday, July 9, 2020 at 8:30 a.m.

Questions:

Q1: Can you confirm the well has a minimum 4" inside diameter from top to bottom, including the reduction of couplings and the inside diameter of the screen.

A1: Measurement indicates that the inside diameter of the well casing is 4 and 3/16 inches. The inside of the well casing appears to be smooth, and there are no known couplings or joints inside the casing.

Q2: Can you find out what the wall thickness is on the 304 SS blank casing?

A2: Measurement indicates that the thickness is 1/8 of an inch.

Q3: After submittal of an invoice, what is the total days for payment to the contractor?

A3: Invoices are typically paid within 30 days of receipt provided they present no issues that need to be resolved, and less any retainage set forth in the agreement.

Q4: Is there a prevailing wage rate assigned to the project? If there is where can the wage determination be reviewed?

A4: No.

Q5: Are certified payroll reports required?

A5: No.

Q6: Is the well under artesian conditions?

A6: No.

Q7: Is there an aquitard between the two screened intervals?

A7: Yes.

Q8: The first sentence of the “Well Abandonment Agreement” states having a local address. Is bidding restricted to resident bidders only or is it open to all contractors who are legally licensed and registered with the Public Works Agency?

A8: A bidder need not have a local address. The Agreement will be modified if necessary to accommodate an out of state bidder. Qualifications of bidders are set forth in the Solicitation of Bids.
