






## NOTICE OF SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT

Pursuant to Idaho Code Section 67-2808(2), Canyon County hereby provides notice that it intends to obtain by sole source procurement a 2022 Kenworth Model T370 Chassis with Cobalt Service Body from Kenworth Sales Company, Boise, for use at the Pickles Butte Sanitary Landfill. The cost of this service truck will be \$200,878.00, consisting of \$103,778.00 for the Kenworth Chassis, and \$97,100.00 for the Cobalt Service Body build. The Board of County Commissioners declares, after due diligence, that there is only one (1) vendor for this equipment, because only one (1) source of the equipment is reasonably available for the following reasons: 1) the cost of the Chassis is determined under the Sourcewell cooperative agreement program, and therefore deemed to be compliant with purchasing standards under Idaho Code Section 67-2807; and 2) the customized Cobalt Service Body build has been deemed superior to other alternatives and more compatible with the servicing of existing equipment. As a result, such further competitive solicitation would be impractical, disadvantageous or unreasonable under the circumstances. The Board intends to consider executing this purchase after taking comment on the record on **April 15, 2021 at 9:00 a.m.**, in the Commissioners' meeting room located on the first floor of the Canyon County Courthouse, 1115 Albany Street, Caldwell, ID, 83605. Written comments regarding such proposed sole source procurement may be directed to the Board at the same address.
